Our area is the fastest growing population and business base in the state, with the number of businesses here doubling in the past 10 years and many more expected in the future as Kapolei builds out.</p> <p>For business, time is money and traffic congestion adds unnecessarily to the cost of doing business. Many of us, our employees and our customers have to travel regularly between downtown Honolulu and Kapolei. Delays due to traffic are more often the norm rather than the exception. The FEIS states that it will take 38 minutes to travel from the East Kapolei station to downtown.
